# What is Title I?

Title I is a program that provides funds from the federal government to improve student learning.



# Purpose of Title I

The purpose of Title I is to ensure that all children have fair, equal and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and at a minimum, reach proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and assessments.



# Who Receives Title I Funds?

Eligible entities receive Title I funds based primarily on U.S. Census data of low-income students: however, services are provided to students identified as having the greatest need for assistance and most at risk of failing challenging state academic standards.



# Our Goals...

- Increase academic achievement
- Provide direct instructional support
- Provide professional development for teachers and staff
- Promote parent and family engagement



# WMES is a Schoolwide Program

A “schoolwide program may serve all students in a school, rather than providing separate services. A schoolwide program allows the school significant flexibilities, as it considers all students to be Title I-eligible students and all teachers to be Title I teachers. To be eligible to be a schoolwide program, 40 percent or more of the students must be identified as low-income. A school must complete a comprehensive one-year planning process.

# Parent Rights to Know

Parents have the right to know about the teaching qualifications of your child's classroom teacher and/or paraprofessional in a school receiving Title I funds



# Parents have the Right to Know...



- Whether the teacher has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived;
- Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher; and
- Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.



# Title I Parent and Family Engagement Policy

- Share information about the importance of the involvement of parents and how it directly affects the success of your children's educational efforts

The School-Parent Compact is a written agreement distributed to parents annually.
